Mark Meylan is internationally recognised as one of London's top singing teachers specialising in musical theatre. He is currently vocal coach for The Book of Mormon and I Can't Sing (X Factor musical) and has worked as resident vocal coach on numerous West End shows such as Ghost the Musical, Jersey Boys, Thoroughly Modern Millie, Sister Act, Saturday Night Fever (London and Cologne), Mamma Mia (London & International tour) & Flashdance (London and UK tour). Mark has also been appointed to train and monitor singers from Chicago, Les Misérables (stage and screen), Bombay Dreams, Cats, Footloose, Our House and Guys and Dolls. In his private studio, Mark also teaches clients from all areas of contemporary commercial music, particularly singers of jazz, pop, folk and world music. He also retrains injured voices, working in association with laryngologists, speech and language therapists and manual voice therapists. Mark has given numerous papers, workshops and master classes within Europe, USA and Australia.
